It has been stated if working from home check your insurance policy it may not suit your requirements. EG visitors to your home,

V.S.I 6 requires an engineering certificate if you increase engine capacity by more than 20%. If vehicle is on H plates it must go onto CVS rego or heavy fine will apply.

CMC will be asking all affiliated clubs when it has finalised survey form to have each member complete the survey in a complete and honest manner. This survey if not completed by each member we may lose our old cars.

From 1<sup>st</sup> November new laws were passed under vehicle safety. Vehicle parked unattended of 28 days will be issued with a notice to remove vehicle within 15 days or a \$660 fine will be imposed. If It's not removed fine will increase to \$1500 and so on. This includes car/boat trailers, Caravans etc
